SUMMARY OF MAIN RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1. To contribute to the creation of a pleasant environment as part of the Care Team, by undertaking a variety of group and one to one activities.
- 2. To provide quality care, under the supervision of the Care Team Manager, by attending to residents' physical and personal needs which may include toileting, feeding and any other personal needs.
- 3. To talk and listen to individuals and help them overcome any anxieties whilst respecting their rights to privacy and dignity.
- 4. To help residents enjoy the facilities of the home al all times whilst retaining as much of their own independence as possible.
- 5. To encourage contacts with friends and family, activities in the community and personal shopping.
- 6. To liaise with residents, management and other team members to produce and deliver a varied, entertaining and stimulating activities programme.
- 7. To identify suitable volunteers to compliment the work of other staff, thus making use of their skills and experience.
- 8. To assist in the production of publicity information relating to residents' activities.
- 9. To assist in fund raising events.
- 10. To help with the preparation and serving of meals and other appropriate domestic tasks as necessary, within the guidelines of the Hygiene Regulations.
- 11. To participate in staff meetings, training and development and staff supervision.
- 12. To comply with all standard procedures concerning the residents' health, safety and welfare.
- 13. To contribute to the preparation and review of individual resident's care plans.
- 14. To assist with the distribution of medication in accordance with the standard procedures, under the general supervision of the Care Team Manager.
